

Tech Sheet for Maritime Marionettes Bridge Theatre

We provide: ~Sound System ~ Lighting system ~ Marionette Bridge Stage

Loading:

Please, check that access to the loading door is clear and reasonably free of ice and snow in the winter.

1. Arrival time: 1 hour and 15 minutes before the start of a school performance 1 hour and 30 minutes before the start of a public performance
2. Load out time: Begins 30 minutes after the end of the performance

Stage, electrical and hall:

- 1. We require a clean (mopped and swept) performance space or stage not less than 12 ft (3.5 m) wide x 6 ft deep (2.35 m) and 7'8" (1.83m) ceiling height.**
2. windows to be covered (blackout enhances performance)
3. One electrical outlet (unblocked by chairs, tables, boxes or equipment)
4. drinking water to be provided for the 2 performers.
5. loud fans, air exchange systems, bells and announcements to be turned off during the performance, (if possible).

Seating:

Generally, children are seated on the floor, and adults are seated on benches or chairs behind them and along the sides.
